HIGHLIGHTS--CONGREGATION COUNCIL MINUTES May 21, 2024

The Congregation Council Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by President JoEllen Myers

I.Reports:

- **a.** Treasurer's Report: Report for April was reviewed by Stephanie Gross. Giving for the month was only \$17,857 which was \$10,000 less than the MSP. Expenses were \$1,000 less than the MSP. Year to Date our Net Loss is \$-6,199.00, which is close to MSP projection.
- b. Financial Secretary's Report: The April report was included in the packet. Denny had no additional comments.
- **c. Secretary's Report:** Minutes from April 16, 2024, Council meeting were presented. Correction under Faith In Action, Tree Planting should have included Rodney Gross as a participant.
- **d. Pastor's Report**: Report for April 17-May 21 was emailed to members prior to meeting. The Pastor also reported on the following membership activity.

 - ii.Love INC: \$480.00
 - iii. Hershey Food Bank: \$661.25 {Contributions-\$250 and Souper Bowl of Caring-\$411.25}
- f. Ministry Teams:
 - i. Property Committee minutes-May 14, 2024, meeting.
 - 1. Chip Haak reported that the projects are complete, however, some start-up glitches with the A/C need to be resolved. Heim and A/C vendor working on it.
 - 2. Phase 3-Sanctuary Renewal is underway with updated costs being obtained.
- **g. Extended Ministries:** A recommendation for \$8,000 from the annual endowment allotment to pay a portion of the HVAC costs was presented by JoEllen Myers. Approval of recommendation by Susan Bianchi, second by Mark Mariano. Recommendation approved.
 - i. Final Bill-Phase 2, Chip Haak explained that the final bill for the HVAC project is \$23,129.86 plus \$1,368.00 for landscaping around the outside compressor. We have some money in the Capital Repair Funds but not enough to cover these costs. Chip reviewed funding options which he had discussed with Nathan Paul from Finance. After discussion and various suggestions, the Council decided on the following: *A motion* to pay the final HVAC bill and landscaping costs using the \$8,000 from Extended Ministries (approved above), \$15,000 from the Bequested Funds, and the remaining \$1,497.86 from the Money Market Capital Repair Fund. Motion made by Mark Mariano, second by Jim Huebner, Council approved.
- **h. Mutual Ministry:** Pastor Brommer requested that Donna Artley be appointed as a committee member with a term ending in 2026.
 - A motion by Will Mariano, second by Beth Dunham. Motion approved.
- II. New Business:
 - **a. Termination of 216 Cocoa Avenue Lease:** Chip Haak explained that Property Committee in consultation with our Real Estate agent has decided to terminate the month to month lease with the tenants at 216 rental property. Chip summarized

that the church had been very understanding many years ago when the tenants experienced financial difficulties, including allowing them to miss some rent payments and later dealing with insufficient funds rent payments. We have kept the rent below market rate in order to be understanding of the tenant's financial situation (which has now been resolved). Recently we have had difficulty getting landlord needed access o the property and when it has been granted, we have found that the cleanliness and condition of the property has deteriorated. The property needs repairs which require access to the property, and we want to return the property to the very good condition the property was in when the tenants moved in. It also presents an opportunity to increase the rent to a market rate. A draft copy of the termination letter was included in the Council packet.

A motion to proceed with the lease termination was made by Mark Mariano, second by Kndra Ruhl. Motion passed.

b. June Council meeting:

- i. No Council meeting in June, July meeting will be held in-person in the Fellowship Hall at 6:30pm on July 8th. Dinner to be served.
- III. Next Council Meeting: July 8, 2024, in-person @6:30pm

IV. Adjournment:

A motion to adjourn by Deb Brooks and second by Mark Mariano, approved by Council. The meeting concluded at 8:10pm with Lord's Prayer



TIME TO MAKE SCHOOL KITS!

We will assemble School Kits on *Gods Work, Our Hands Sunday* on September 8th. We are collecting supplies for School Kits. We can't control when disasters strike and we can't end poverty overnight, but there are things we can do to help people around the world reach their full potential. School kits are a great way to help! The church will supply the backpacks. We need you to provide the supplies to go inside the backpacks. Several stores in the area will have school supplies on sale or you can order supplies online. Please bring your items to the collection site in the Narthex) or put the following items into a plastic bag and drop them off in the bin on the back porch of the office (it's there now!).

If you are not comfortable shopping, you can make a monetary donation. Make your check payable to Holy Trinity Lutheran Church and write "school kits" on the memo line. Checks can be mailed to the office, put in the offering or put through the mail slot by the front door of the office. Thank you for your generosity!

Items needed for each School Kit:

- ◆ Four 70-sheet notebooks of wide- or college-ruled paper approximately 8" X 10½"; no loose-leaf paper
- One 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
- One pencil sharpener
- One blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- Five unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band
- Five black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink); secure together with a rubber band
- One box of 16 or 24 crayons (Crayola brand is preferred because they don't melt as easily)
- One eraser approximately 2 1/2" long




