

Intentional Interim Pastor

On May 20th the Council approved a letter of agreement with The Rev. Pamela J. Carnes to serve as our fulltime Intentional Interim Pastor beginning June 9th. She recently finished serving in the same capacity at Trinity, Steelton and St. Peter's Highspire. Pastor Carnes is certified as an intentional interim Pastor and has served in that role for over six years at various congregations throughout Pa. As an intentional pastor, in addition to providing Pastoral leadership, she acts a resource for the congregation, providing guidance during this transitional period, and preparing us for the future. Pastor Carnes will serve until we call a new Pastor.

June 1st -Pastor Larry Hummer will come to our rescue to fill one of the open Sundays between interim Pastors.

June 8th -Pastor Beth Martini, Assistant to the Synod Bishop, will join us to lead worship on Pentecost and "Affirmation of Baptism" (Confirmation) for five of our youth.

June 9th –Pastor Carnes will begin her service & will be in the pulpit starting June 15th.

HIGHLIGHTS CONGREGATION COUNCIL MINUTES April 22, 2025

The Congregation Council Meeting was called to order at 7:01pm by President Rodney Gross

I.Reports:

- **a.** Treasurer's Report: Report for March was reviewed by Stephanie Gross. Giving for the month was good, and even with quarterly expenses of taxes and insurance, we still had Net Income of \$2,110. This brought the YTD Net Income up to \$3,703.
 - i. Quarterly reports for Special Accounts, Youth Investment, Endowment Fund, and Capital Repair Fund included in packet. Noted that the Endowment and Youth Investment fund had losses due to current market conditions.
- b. Financial Secretary's Report: The March report was included in the packet. Denny had no additional comments.
- c. Secretary's Report: Minutes from March 18th Council Meeting were included in the Council packet.
- d. Pastor's Report:
 - i. Pastor Mill's Report for period March 18th -April 22nd emailed prior to meeting.
 - 1. Noted in the reports was that she sent 20 Easter cards/note to our shut-ins.
 - 2. Pastor also reported that after her time with us she will be joining "Nomads on A Mission Active in Divine Service." The members of this (Methodist) organization travel via RVs to different areas of the country doing service projects.
- e. Correspondence: Thank You for financial support
 - i. Christ Lutheran Church-\$1,000
 - ii.Christian Churches United-\$1,000
 - iii. Hershey Food Bank-290lbs non-perishable food
- f. Ministry Teams:
 - i. **Grow:** Affirmation of Baptism (Confirmation)
 - 1. Chip Haak reported that there are five youth eligible. The date for this Service is under discussion with the parents of the youth.
 - 2. Camper person update:
 - a. Nawakwa Summer camp starts June 22nd and runs thru August 8th.
 - b. Kirchenwald Summer camp starts June 15th and runs through August 8th.

ii. Witness: Faith In Action

- 1. Personal Care Kits- Will be collected through the end of April with a 50 kit goal. We have 74 kits!!
- 2. Adopt-A-Highway-Clean-up was on Saturday April 5th. Before the rain started at 9:50am and curtailed their work, (9) volunteers collected (8) 45-gallon bags of trash, some full, some half full.
- iii. Share:
- 1. **Property Committee**: Minutes from April 8th meeting included in packet.
 - a. Chip Haak reported that the rent payment from the new tenants in 216 Cocoa is late again. Karen Kline has contacted our real-estate agent to inform him of the situation and discuss actions to ensure timely payments. The tenants have also not transferred the water bill to their name.

II. Unfinished Business:

- **a. Synod Assembly:** Will be held June 5th-7th and our delegates will be JoEllen Myers and Rodney Gross. Agenda will include the election of a new Bishop for the Lower Susquehanna Synod.
- **b.** Pastoral Transition Update:
 - i. Call Committee has been organized and held (2) meetings thus far.
 - 1. Working on a survey to obtain input from members to be used to develop sections of the Ministry Site Profile.
 - 2. Contract with "bridge" Pastor Mills has been extended thru the end of May
 - 3. Synod has potential "interim" pastor candidate which the Executive Committee will interview in the next two weeks.
 - a. Pastor Carol Bowman will supply on May 18th.

- c. Opening and Closing of Church for Services: (previously done by John Brommer)
 - i. Thanks to those who have helped so far: Alan Hair, Chip Haak, Kirk Sponaugle, Steve Shuey, Rodney Gross.

III. New Business:

- **a. 2025 Extended Ministries appointments:** Committee chair, JoEllen Myers made a motion to add Elizabeth Stuart as committee member with a term ending in 2026. Second by Joan Rizzo. Motion approved.
- IV. Next Council Meeting: May 20, 2025, 7pm via Zoom
 - V. Adjournment: A *motion* to adjourn by Beth Dunham and second by JoEllen Myers, approved by Council. The meeting concluded at 8:20pm with Lord's Prayer.



Lutheran Day at the Capitol

On a rainy Tuesday in May, three intrepid members of Holy Trinity participated in Lutheran Day at the Capitol 2025. Sponsored by LAMPa, Lutheran Advocacy Ministry in PA, Lutheran advocates from across the Commonwealth gathered to be grounded and equipped to act together on issues that make a difference to the wellbeing of the world God loves.

Jen Keeler, and Julia and Alan Hair spent the morning attending workshops and hearing inspirational speakers at Trinity Lutheran in Camp Hill. Topics such as Advocacy 101, Church in the Public Space, Baptism in a Time of Breakdown and PA Food Policy Council: A Whole-of-Government Approach to Food & Nutrition Security, were covered. Following lunch, the group participated in a worship service before boarding buses to the Capitol to meet with legislators. A representative from Tom Mehaffe's office (106th district) met with us to listen to our request to increase funding for the State Food Purchase Program (SFPP) and the PA Agricultural Surplus System (PASS) in the 2025-2026 budget. We also asked Representative Mehaffe to support HB 79, Medical Debt Prevention legislation. Representative Mehaffe was in session at the time of our visit and voted YES to HR 79. Other constituents from the 15th district visited Senator Patti Kim's office.

There is power in numbers; Lutheran Day at the Capitol is an annual event. Maybe God is calling you to advocacy? Consider joining us next year!






- White construction paper (11" x 13" sheet)


